DIVISION 1 MEETINGS BEGIN AT 12 NOON

THE COMBINED DIVISION 2 & 3 MEETINGS BEGIN AT 11.30 A.M.

CLUBS MUST PROVIDE THEIR OWN VEST NUMBERS FRONT AND BACK (Except High Jumps where single front number suffices). A template will be provided which they can photocopy.

Teams must be declared at least 30 minutes before start of meetings

The following pages contain timetables for the 3 matches – separate timetables for Division 1 and the combined Divisions 2 and 3

Athletes U17 or below are restricted to a maximum of 3 individual events plus relay CSSAL from 2007 Masters: Male 35 years plus: Female 35 years plus

Convening Clubs

If two clubs are sharing the first named club will receive the paperwork and be ultimately responsible for the results. However, they should agree on who does what to make best use of resources.

Prior to the athletic meeting, the convening club (s) should prepare the field and track pads with club names and start order where available. The convening club should make themselves familiar with the points scoring (in this handbook). Points are awarded for track and field events and for providing officials.

The committee division representative should be available on competition day to check everything is in place, give admin advice and help on league management decisions (named near the front of handbook).

The convening club on arrival shall collate the declaration sheets and add the athlete names to the field sheets and if start sheets are provided for track races, should add the athletes' names to the sheets (requires lane order). **NB:** If results sheets are provided this can only be added after the event (doesn't require lane order).

Ideally the convening club should provide an announcer to operate the stadium public address equipment. Please avoid making announcements when the athletes are on their marks during track events so that they can hear the instructions of the start team. The announcer should highlight programme information (calling athletes to a field or track event etc) and any special announcements requested by the referees.

The lists of officials should be checked and any shortfall (5 officials per club should be chased). Field officials should be provided to the Field Referee and Track officials to the Track Referee.

Tea tickets (2010, value £3.50) should be arranged to be distributed through the field and track referees. The first aid team and admin team should also be given a ticket.

The convening club should collate the results as they come in. They may need to arrange collection of the results from the track referee and field referee. The results should be checked against league records and Scottish standards and any exceptional performances should be highlighted to the league secretary.

The convening club(s) should then enter the results into the MS Excel spreadsheet provided onto a lap top computer.

Once entered into computer the results should be displayed if possible for athletes and team managers to view them. Any queries should first be referred to the track and field referees.

At the end of the meeting, an unscrutinised electronic copy of the results should be emailed to the league secretary and the division scrutineer. At the end of the day the results and declaration sheets should be handed over to the scrutineer to take away. Email addresses are listed in this handbook at the front.

Central & South of Scotland Athletic League (formerly SNWAL)

1. INTERPRETATION

The final responsibility for the interpretation of these regulations rests with the relevant Referee subject only to the AGM or Special Meeting. A Special Meeting shall be called by at least four Member Clubs. The Clubs calling such a Meeting will be expected to make a deposit of £25, returnable if the complaint is upheld.

2. SCORING

16, 14, 12, 10, 8, 6, 5, 4 both A –events and in relays. 12, 10, 8, 6, 4, 3, 2, 1 for B events.

ALL POINTS (including those in a relay) gained by an athlete who infringes the Rules regarding the number of events shall be deducted from the Club's score. After each meeting the winning Club shall be awarded 8 points, the second 7 points etc. In the event of a tie at the end of the season the total of match points shall be used to decide the positions.

3. OFFICIALS.

Each Club MUST provide at least FIVE Officials, who should be at least 17 years of age and be available for the whole meeting. Although it is not essential, it is preferable that at least three of these Officials be graded by SAL (or equivalent) Officials Commission. Each Team will be awarded 20 points for each Graded Official and 10 points for each un-graded Official up to a maximum of 5 Officials. Officials should report to the Divisional Representative THIRTY minutes prior to the start of the meeting and it is the responsibility of each Club to ensure that each of its nominated Officials report for his/her allocated duty. In addition to the duties on the day the Convening Lead Club Convener will be responsible for ensuring that the results papers are despatched to the Scrutineer or League Secretary, without delay in order that Clubs can be furnished with reliable results as soon as possible after each match.

4. AGE GROUPS.

The League will operate over six age groups for males and females. Competitors, except Masters and Under 17 Women, may only compete in their own age group.

The age groups will be u-11, u-13, u-15, u-17, Seniors/U20 and Masters (Over 35 male & female).

These age groups will be determined in the same manner as those of the UKA.

NO PERSON UNDER THE AGE OF NINE YEARS ON THE DAY OF COMPETITION WILL BE ALLOWED TO COMPETE UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES

5. COMPETITION.

The League will provide competition as detailed in the various meeting schedules.

6. CONDUCT OF TEAMS.

The conduct of Club Members is the responsibility of the Clubs who shall nominate a Team Manager on their Declaration Sheet at each Meeting. Clubs are particularly asked to ensure that their members do not 'run around' unnecessarily in the Stadium and that they warm up in the appropriate area. This applies at all times but particularly once the meeting has started.

7. TEAM DECLARATIONS.

These must be handed into the Results Officers at least THIRTY MINUTES prior to the starting time of the Meeting. PENALTY 25 Points unless sufficient reason is shown why points should not be deducted. Should a Team be delayed e.g. transport break down, an attempt should be made to contact a League Office Bearer or the stadia that will pass on the information to the appropriate Match Officials. **Declarations must** be made on the OFFICIAL SHEETS, which should be completed in BLOCK LETTERS and should include the names of those in the RELAY teams. Any athlete, up to and including under 17, and Masters, whose date of birth is not quoted and any athlete whose Athletics Scotland Number is not quoted, will be excluded from the points scoring. The only exceptions to the Athletics Scotland Number Rule is where the Scottish Athletics Competition Levy is paid, (this must be marked on the Declaration Sheet) or an application form is completed and is attached to the declaration sheet. In the event of an application having been made to Scottish Athletics and the number not received by the date of the meeting this should also be noted in order that the scrutineer may check with the membership Administrator. Any changes in competitors names MUST BE NOTIFIED to the Results Officials before the event in question. SEE ALSO RULE 2

8. ELIGIBILITY.

Clubs may use FIRST and SECOND CLAIM Members at all Meetings as the League can [under UKA Rule 4 (12)] recognise Second Claim status, since the competition is confined to Scottish Clubs.

NO GUEST COMPETITORS WHO ARE MEMBERS OF MEMBER CLUBS WILL BE PERMITTED.

At the discretion of the Committee special dispensation to allow outside guests may be granted in special circumstances provided the athlete's Club Secretary makes the approach

9. LEAGUE AWARDS

There will be winner's trophies for each Division and a runner's up trophy for Division 1. Clubs are asked to ensure that these are available for presentation at the Annual General Meeting

10. NUMBERS

The allocated numbers will be used for the complete season and, in the case of a sponsors name being added to the number cards, the Club is responsible for ensuring that these are collected at the end of a meeting to ensure full exposure, at all meetings, for the sponsor.

These will be used as follows:

A String = ODD number B String = EVEN number.

ALL ATHLETES must in addition to wearing the correct number, be wearing a vest in the colours of their Club to which their numbers, which should not be folded, cut or mutilated in any way, are SECURELY fixed BACK AND FRONT (except High Jumpers and Pole Vaulters who may wear one number)

11. ORGANISATION SEE ALSO PARAGRAPH NUMBER 17

- a. Only in Sprint Events (up to 400m and hurdles) is it necessary to nominate A & B Strings. In all other events, including Field events, the best performance will be deemed to be the A String for scoring purposes.
- b. Officials shall allow an athlete to compete out of order if competing in another event but ONLY BY ADJUSTING THE COMPETITOR'S POSITION IN A PARTICULAR ROUND (per UKA Rules) Field events will be administered separately for each Division EXCEPT that the HIGH JUMP will be run concurrently for both Divisions where there are two Divisions at one meeting

TO SPEED THE EVENT THE HIGH JUMP WILL HE PROGRESSED AS FOLLOWS

U13 Boys 1.15-1.20-1.25-1.28 then by choice

U15 Boys 1.30- 1.35-1.40-1.45-1.48 then by choice

U17/Senior Men 1.40-1.50-1.55-1.60 then by choice

Senior Men 1.50-1.55-1.60 then by choice

U13 Girls 1.00-1.10-1.15-1.20-1.25-1.28 then by choice

U15 Girls 1.10- 1.15-1.20-1.25-1.30-1.35-1.38 then by choice

U17/Sen Women 1.15-1.20-1.30-1.35-1.40-1.43 then by choice

To facilitate the inclusion of all Field Events in the programme the following Regulations have been deemed necessary, and it is essential that all athletes and Officials are aware of and adhere to these.

- a. All Shot Putt Competitions will be decided on **THREE TRIALS ONLY** as per paragraph 11b
- b. All warming up at a competition site will consist of **TWO trials ONLY**, in competition order, prior to starting the competition.
- c. HIGH JUMP STARTING HEIGHTS will, in an attempt to avoid athletes starting at a height lower than they require to, be increased to: -

U13 Boys 1m15 (Min 1m00) U15 Boys 1m30 (Min 1m20)

U17 Men 1m40 (Min 1m30) Senior Men 1m50 (Min 1m30)

U13 Girls 1m10 (Min 1m00) U15 Girls 1m20 (Min 1m10)

U17 and Senior Women 1m30 (Min 1m15)

Any athlete wishing to start at a lower height will be allowed a total of three trials at or above the minimum starting heights quoted in paragraph 11c and, assuming such athlete has not been eliminated from the competition, they will be allowed to continue above the newly set starting heights. This would mean that, for example, an under 13 boy could start at 1m00 and should he clear that height at his second attempt he would only be allowed trial at 1m10 and should he fail that he would be out of the competition. Should he clear 1m10 he would be allowed to continue in the competition. If, however, he were to clear 1m00 at his third attempt his next trial would require being at 1m15.

d. The number of events in which an athlete may be declared <u>and/or</u> compete is, in the case of athletes up to and including the under 17 age group, restricted by the UKA Rule to a maximum of **4** Events, <u>at least one</u> of which must be a **relay**. In the case of females Under 15 they must NOT compete in both 800m and 1500m on the same day. In addition, an Under 17 Woman may not compete in a Senior Event

unless there is no comparable Under 17 Women's Event or unless she competes as a Senior for the WHOLE meeting.

12. LEAGUE OFFICIALS.

It is expected that all Athletes, Team Officials and Spectators will co-operate with League and Technical Officials at all times.

13. GENERAL

Anything not covered in these rules shall be subject to interpretation in the light of the relevant rules of the UKA.

14. HANDBOOK

The League Handbook shall be produced each year to ensure that all information is kept up to date. An Electronic copy (CD rom) will be issued to each Club at the start of the Season and the Handbook will be available electronically by email by requesting a copy from the League Secretary.

15. FINANCE

The Affiliation Fee for 2010 shall be £160 per Club and is payable by 1st April. Clubs may be liable to a levy of 50% if this is necessary to cover expenditure. Any Club having difficulty with this should approach the Treasurer immediately.

16. RULE INFRINGEMENTS

Any Club found to be deliberately infringing the Rules of Competition will be fined 5 League Points, in respect of each infringement. The interpretation of this Rule lies with the Executive and any decision is subject to appeal to the Annual General Meeting or an Extraordinary General Meeting if called for this purpose.

17.GUILLOTINE. Meetings will stop, at the decision of the Divisional representative in consultation with the referees, NO LATER than 6.00pm **WITHOUT CONSULTATION**.

CONSTITUTION

<u>OF</u>

THE CENTRAL AND SOUTH OF SCOTLAND ATHLETIC LEAGUE

1. TITLE

The League will be known as "The Central and South of Scotland Athletic League" and will, where appropriate, include a sponsor's name in the Title.

2. AIMS & OBJECTIVES

To promote athletic competition amongst member clubs.

- a. To provide competition for athletes of both sexes and all ages over 9 years within the context of a league system of competition with competitors receiving points and clubs rising and falling within the League in accordance with their overall strength as illustrated by the points they score in every agegroup.
- b. To keep records of achievement for every athletic event within the league programme.
- c. To promote athletics as a family sport through the provision of competition in every age group recognised by the League.
- d. To help member clubs make all forms of athletics as attractive as possible through the promotion of competition and such other activity as the member clubs consider it worthwhile to promote.

3. THE GOVERNANCE OF THE LEAGUE.

- a. Provisions made in the annual yearbook, which is revised at every Annual General Meeting, shall govern the League.
- b. The League shall work within the framework of this constitution and the rules of the Governing Bodies of Athletics.

4. THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE LEAGUE.

- a. The administration of the League shall be supervised by the Executive Committee, which shall have the right to act on behalf of all member clubs when any contentious matters arise within the year spanned by two Annual General Meetings, subject only to guidance from a prior Annual General Meeting.
- b. The Executive Committee shall consist of the following who shall be elected at the Annual General Meeting and whose duties are described here.

CHAIRMAN.

The Chairman will preside at all business meetings. Should he be unable to do so, The Vice Chairman will take his place. Should both the Chairman and Vice Chairman be absent, a temporary Chairman must be elected by those present at the meeting.

VICE-CHAIRMAN. As described above.

SECRETARY/RECORDS OFFICER

The Secretary will be the League's correspondent. It will fall to him to arrange the compilation of the handbook including the maintenance of details of record performances and the maintenance of those tables in the handbook, which list the previous winners of the League and Divisional titles.

TREASURER.

The Treasurer will keep the League's Accounts and be responsible for the collection of the membership fees, the amount of which will be fixed at the Annual General Meeting, and which shall be due on 1 April annually. The Executive Committee shall have the power to impose a levy on member clubs and/or to arrange Overdraft Facilities not exceeding 20% of the League's annual

income, should this prove necessary to cover the League's expenses.

ASSISTANT SECRETARY.

The Assistant Secretary will be responsible for maintaining a record of the Minutes of General Meetings of the League and of Executive Committee Meetings and for assisting the Secretary as necessary.

SCRUTINEERS

These will be appointed to scrutinise the results of the Division allocated to them and to produce a report covering all matters relating to the results and any changes brought about as a result of the scrutiny.

ADDITIONAL MEMBERS.

There shall be a member of the Executive Committee appointed at the AGM to represent each Division of the League.

Meetings of the Executive Committee will be called as deemed necessary.

MEMBERSHIP OF THE LEAGUE

Membership of the League is open to all Athletic Clubs affiliated to Scottish Athletics Limited or its successor as Governing body of Athletics in Scotland, subject to the approval of member clubs at the Annual General Meeting.

The League shall never exceed four divisions and 32 member clubs. Should the demand for entry exceed this number of clubs entry to and continued membership of Division 4 (for the bottom two Clubs) shall be subject to a Qualifying match the need for which will be decided at the Annual General Meeting.

Any club which shows a lack of interest in the running of the League and that is not prepared to assist with the work involved in ensuring that their Divisional competition is run adequately shall be liable to suspension or expulsion from the League.

The decision that this action has to be taken shall rest with the Executive

Committee, whose decision shall be made following a meeting with Representatives of the Club and shall be final – only subject to a meeting of the General Meeting of the Members, called in accordance with this Constitution, making or rescinding such a decision. The Club will be given the option of two dates on which any meeting in this connection will be held and failure to agree to such a meeting, the Executive will be within their rights to assume that the Club does not intend to provide any answer to the accusation. Any Club so suspended or expelled shall remain liable for the whole subscription set for the year by the Annual General Meeting irrespective of the point in the year at which the suspension or expulsion takes effect.

6. ANNUAL GENERAL MEETINGS & EXTRA-ORDINARY GENERAL MEETINGS

- a. There shall be an Annual General meeting of the league each year. Clubs should ensure that any matters, which they wish raised, should be in the hands of the Secretary no later than 1st October in order that they may be circulated to the Clubs with the Notice calling the Meeting. A minimum of fourteen days notice of the meeting should be given to all member clubs. The subject matter for the agenda of the Annual General Meeting will be decided by the Executive Committee subject to the inclusion of any proposals put forward by member clubs.
- b. An Extra-ordinary General Meeting of the League will be called at the request of the Executive Committee or at the request of not less than FOUR member clubs who will be required to lodge a total Deposit of £25, which shall be refunded unless the calling of the Meeting proves to be un-necessary. The agenda of any Extra-ordinary General Meeting will consist only of the matters causing such a meeting to be called.
- c. Any decisions at a General Meeting of the League will be decided on a vote on the basis of two votes per Club (one for the male section and one for the female section) plus one vote for each of the executive committee of those present and will require a majority as follows:
 - i) Changes in the Constitution will require to be approved by a 2/3 majority of those present and voting provided that the votes cast in favour are at least 50% of those present and entitled to vote.
 - ii) Changes to the Rules for Competition and/or Meeting Schedules will require to be approved by a simple majority.
- d. The Annual General Meeting will decide policy matters.
- e. The execution of the policy will be in the hands of the Executive Committee.

The League will appoint an auditor to review the accounts annually. Audited Accounts will be presented to the Annual General Meeting.

8. ANNUAL REPORTS.

The Chairman, Secretary, Divisional Representatives and Scrutineer will present annual reports to the Annual General Meeting.

9. SCRUTINY

The results sheets necessary to record competition results will be designed in consultation with and scrutinised by the scutineer or other persons appointed to assist with the duty.

10. DISCIPLINE

Any necessary disciplinary action that may be required by the League shall be in the hands of the Executive Committee. Where it is essential that an immediate decision be made this will be the responsibility of the Referee.
