Students in Full-time Education in Scotland

Students in full-time education in Scotland may, at the start of the season, nominate their First Claim Club as their education establishment. This is provided that the Club is confined to students of that establishment and that the Club is affiliated to Scottish Athletics. A first claim member of an education establishment Club may compete, in SAL permitted races, for a second claim Scottish Club in Open team races provided their first claim Club is not entered.

Notes for Competitors

Location | Declarations, changing, showers and refreshments **Deans Community High School.**

> The **new school** is ½ mile north of Livingston North Station and Carmondean Shopping Centre. (see inset location map overleaf).

> Trains from Edinburgh Waverley, at 18 & 48 minutes past each hour, (via Haymarket Edinburgh Park) take 24 minutes.

Parking

Parking is very limited.

Please share lifts, walk, run, cycle, hitch-hike, or come by bus or train.

Courses

Are in Dechmont Law Country Park, behind the school. Access is now through the school. The course is signposted and is less than 400m from the west gate.

Some details are shown on the sketch map overleaf.

The courses are new, though are mostly on sections used for previous events. All are based on the same 3.2 K lap but avoiding some of the more exposed and soggy ground in favour of more on sheltered undulating terrain in woodland.

The courses are all suitable for spikes.

Competitors are advised to recce their course, but should take care not to impede races in progress.

We are grateful to West Lothian Council for splendid assistance in preparing the grass trails.
